Welcome to the 2017 IKO-TAMS Auction. This year's auction includes many scarce and unlisted pieces from IN, OH & KY as well as other interesting items. Lots will be on display at the show in Englewood at the American Legion Post #707 on or before 5:00 on Friday Sept. 22. Bid board bidding at the show will close on Saturday Sept. 23 at 12:30. The floor auction will then follow. G, VG, F, VF, XF, AU and UNC refers to grade. MB signifies Minimum Bid. R with a number signifies catalog rarity rating. Standard token references and abbreviations are used. Each bid at the show must be at least 10% above the previous bid rounded to the whole dollar. Minimum bid is \$5.00 unless noted otherwise. Deadline for mail and email bids is noon (EST) Sept. 7, 2017.

F-AU, AL w/center hole as made, R, 23. Sales tax tokens were used to pay sales tax on small purchases during the Great Depression (instead of being overcharged for a full cent).
45. OPA Ration Tokens.....<32 piece lot, 26 red & 6 blue>:OPA/ (letter)1(letter)/ RED (or BLUE) Point// (same)  
VG-VF, Fiber, R, 17. These were instituted by the Office of Price Administration during WWII as a means of rationing essentials such as food and gasoline and reduce the chance of inflation. The points were used to make change for ration coupons.
46. Medal.....TRANSCONTINENTAL/ RAILROAD/ (steam train engine & car)/ (map of U.S. flanked by two men.)/ THE/ NATION/ UNITED/ BY/ RAIL/ 1869 1969// JUNCTION AT PROMONTORY/(Indian on horseback staring at train in background)/ MAY 10/ 1869  
BU. .925 Silver. R. 30. Medal XXXIII of the series of "So-Called Half Dollars" issued by Robert McNamara of Heraldic Art. Includes original envelope of issue. **MB = \$25.00**
