



FROM THE EAST/WEST: Take I-70 to SR 48 (exit 29). Turn north on SR 48 which becomes SR 48/US 40 (they separate in about 1 mile). At separation, go left on US 40 (West National Road) to the American Legion Hall on the left.

FROM THE NORTH/SOUTH: Take I-75 to I-70. Turn west and follow the East/West directions.

FROM DAYTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT: Exit the airport on Terminal Drive and follow to US 40. Turn right and follow to the US 40/SR 48 junction. Turn right and follow the East/West directions.


